- Please use fresh flowers only
- Please remove all wrapping materials (eg cellophane)
- Please use flower troughs provided; please do not leave your own pots, vases, statuettes etc.
- Please place all funeral tributes at the foot of the cross
- Please note that faded tributes will be removed regularly
- Planting is carried out by the Garden of Remembrance Committee
- There is a risk that an inscription may not appear in chronological sequence if the request is delayed for any reason.

The names **run in a continuous line** to form a page of writing, reminding us that we are all part of the Book of Life.
